

# Creating Center Text Block - Printing Files

---

The download files for our patterns include the print-ready image file of your park name unit.

The file contains four individual printable images, each one with a specific intended use.

There are several techniques you can use to transfer the block name onto your fabric, listed below.

Before attempting any of the listed inkjet printing techniques on your final fabric block, it is **highly recommended** that you run a test print on paper to confirm the image placement and size.

## METHOD #1:

Yellowstone

**INKJET: PRINTABLE FABRIC SHEETS**

UNIT "H" COLORED BACKGROUND

---

Manufacturers that specialize in producing inkjet-printable cloth sheets include:

- **Jacquard**
- **Printed Treasures**
- **Avery**

We recommend following the manufacturer's printing directions.

## METHOD #3:

Yellowstone

Yellowstone

**INKJET: IRON-ON TRANSFER PAPER**

UNIT "H" REVERSED IMAGES

---

Iron-on heat transfer papers from:

- **Avery**
- **A-Sub**
- **Handy Crafts**

Ensure that you have an appropriate transfer paper for your fabric – different types are required for light or dark fabrics.

## METHOD #2:

Yellowstone

**INKJET: FREEZER PAPER PRINTING**

UNIT "H" TRANSPARENT BACKGROUND

---

This method is very economical because it allows you to print on your own fabric. All that is required is some freezer paper.

## METHOD #4:

Yellowstone

**FABRIC MARKERS AND PENS**

---

Utilize this method if you do not have access to an inkjet printer, or would prefer to hand-letter your park title onto your own ivory fabric.

Quality fabric pen manufacturers include:

- **Tuskineko Fabrico**
- **Tulip**
- **Coloré Premium**

We recommend testing the markers on a scrap of fabric before using on your block.
